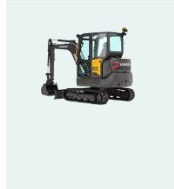

Based in Motherwell, Scotland, Rokbak makes off-highway articulated haulers that are used in mining, quarrying, and construction applications around the world.

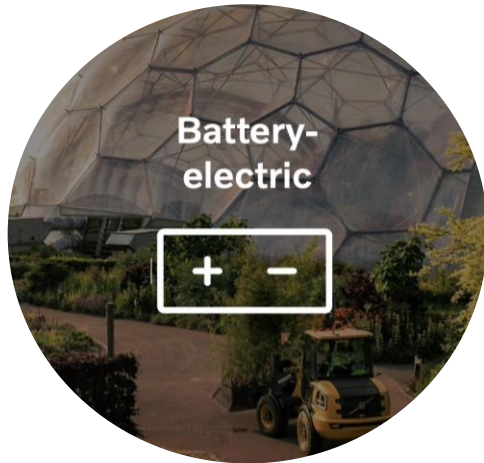

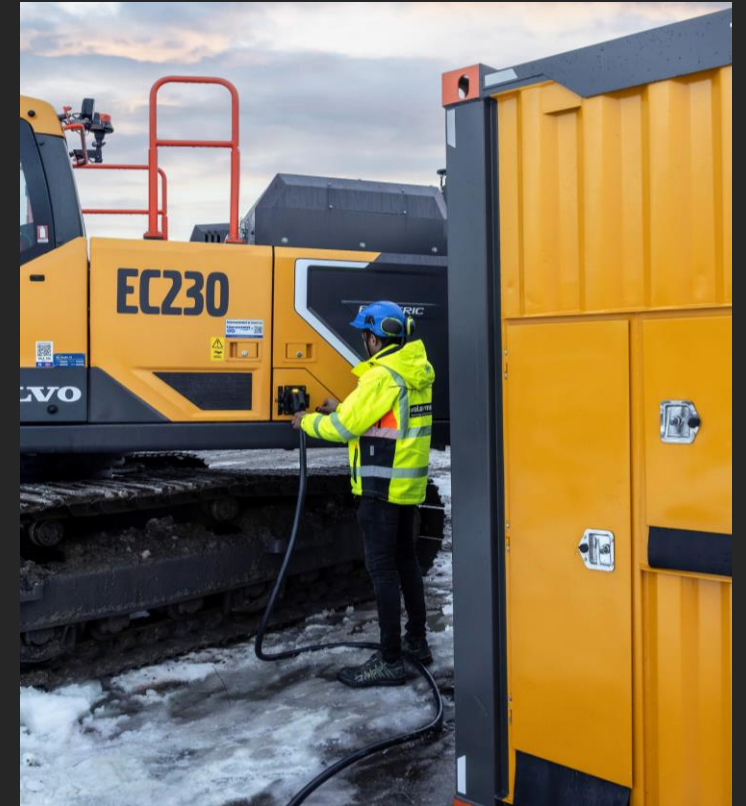


Emission-free worksites

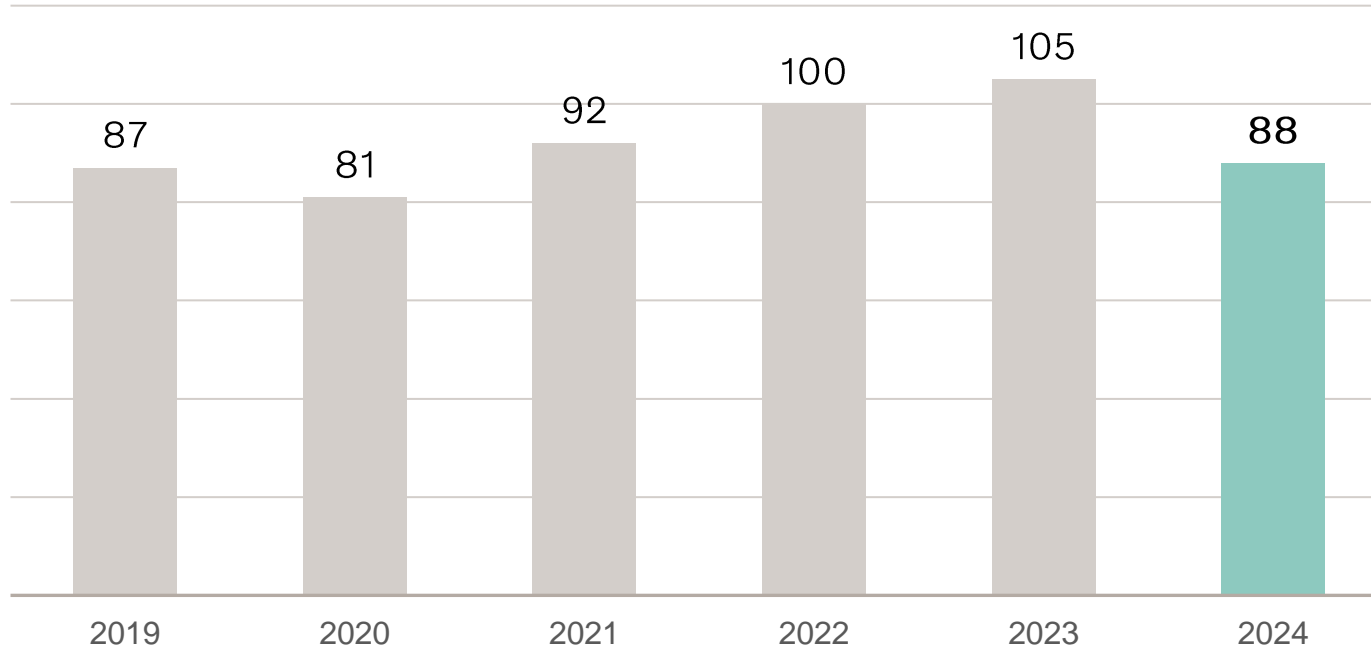

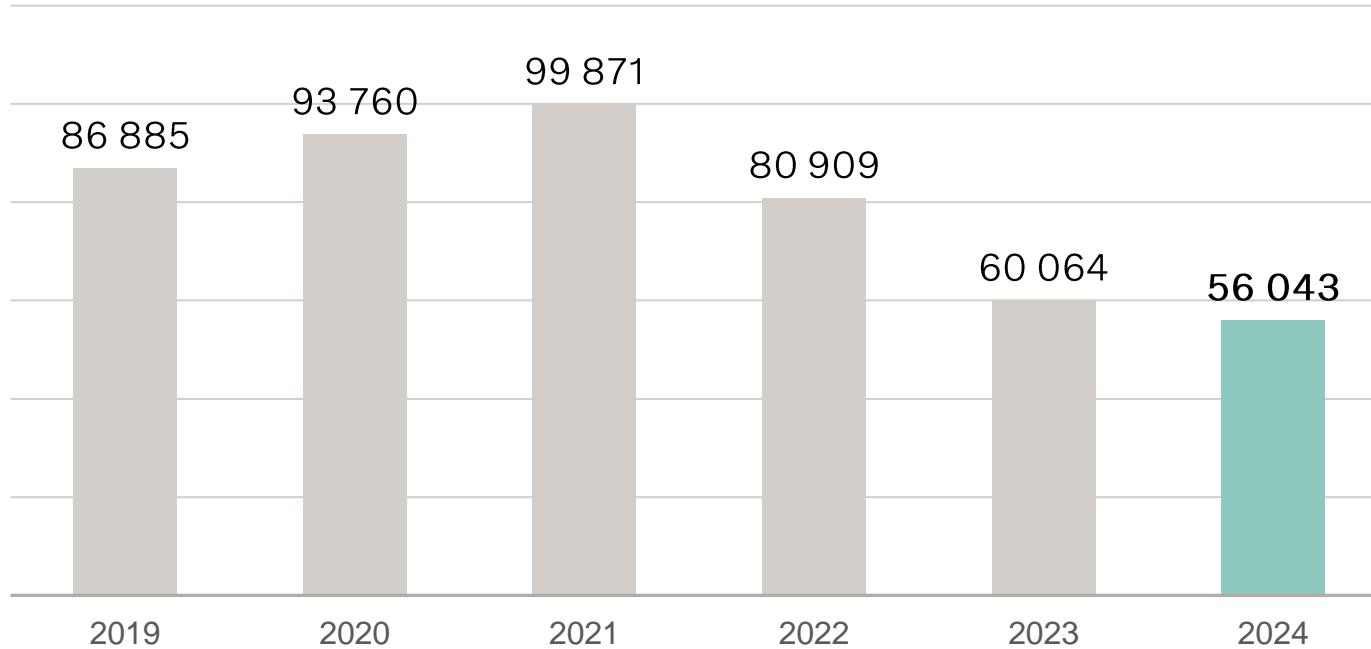

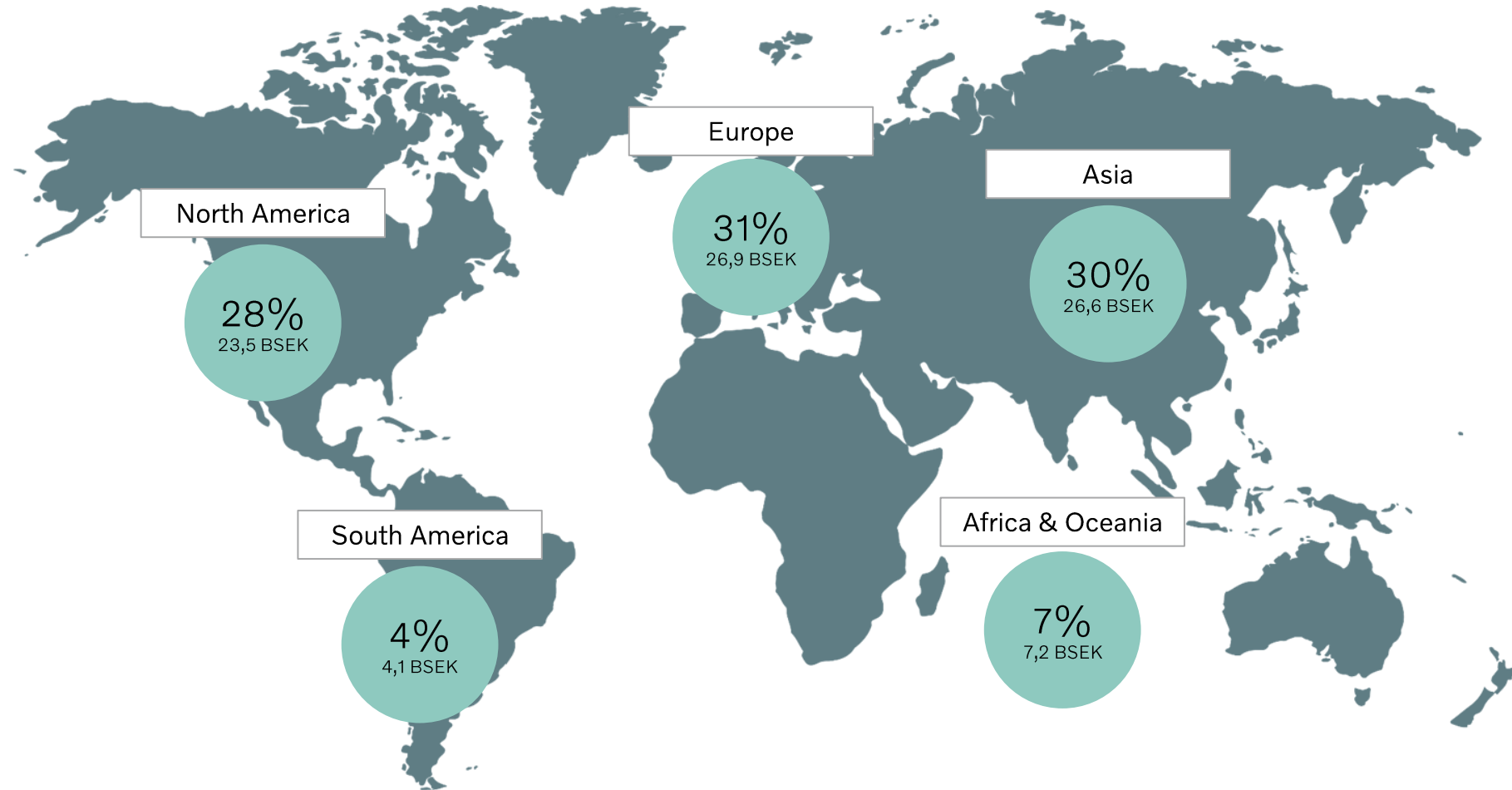
